Definitions:

Community Group (Regular User) - A not for profit, non-restricted membership group or organization whose membership is composed of not fewer than 80% Springfield Township residents and whose activities are consistent with the goals, objectives and standards of the Township.

Community Group (Casual User) - All other Community, Commercial or Private groups who are requesting facility usage. (i.e. One time/irregular use)

Commercial Group - Any individual, company or organization engaged in the pursuit of business for profit through the use of the JEDD facility.

Private Group - Any individual or organization, which does not meet the requirements of the "Community Group", or "Commercial Group" definitions.

Out of Season Activities that take place contrary to generally accepted sport seasons or that would take place contrary to scheduled facility configurations.

Age Classification:

Child/Youth - Under 18 years of age inclusive

Adult/Senior - 18 years of age and older

Equity:

Practice permit: \$50

Lighting Fee: \$30 to turn on lights/\$5 per game (1 game = \$35; 2 games = \$40)

Responsibility: Tournament Directors are ultimately responsible for the actions of ALL persons associated with the tournament. Also, alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the property. Failure to adhere to the policy will result in immediate expulsion from the property and may include permanent expulsion.

Hold Harmless Agreement:

In consideration of the receipt of this permit from Springfield Township, the Permittee hereby releases Springfield Township/City of Akron and agrees to indemnify and HOLD HARMLESS Springfield Township/City of Akron, its agents, or servants from all damages, including, but not limited to, attorney fees and other costs resultant from any injury to Permittee or any agent or employee of Permittee, or to any person coming upon the premises in connection with the Permittee’s use and occupancy of the premises. In no event shall Springfield Township/City of Akron be liable for any damage or injury to Permittee or any agent or employee or Permittee or to any person coming upon the premises in connection with the Permittee’s use and occupancy of the premises. Permittee acknowledges that it shall reimburse Springfield Township/City of Akron for any and all damage to Springfield Township/City of Akron property, its agents, and/or its servants, as a result of the use and occupancy of the premises (ordinary wear and tear excepted) by Permittee, its agents, or servants, or by any person coming upon the premises during the Permittee’s use as an invitee or licensee of the Permittee. Permittee agrees that the rights and obligations under the permit and this agreement shall inure to and be binding on its successors and assigns.

This HOLD HARMLESS agreement MUST be signed by Permittee in his or her individual or representative capacity as an authorized representative of the organization named below, which representative represents by so signing that he or she has the authority to bind such organization, and received and accepted by Springfield Township/City of Akron before any permit will be issued.
